You probably had no idea that Delft boasted such a lovely camping site? Yet, it is true. Delftse Hout Recreation Centre is a unique nature area right in the centre of the urban agglomeration of Western Holland.

A magnificent camping, chalet and caravan site with many activities, closely situated to one of the prettiest places in the Netherlands: Delft. The fact that Delftse Hout Recreation Centre is situated in a nature reserve of the same name makes it particularly special. It is a vast area that is linked with the surrounding recreational areas of the towns of Nootdorp and Zoetermeer. You even have a real recreational lake at your disposal. The nice thing about Delftse Hout is the unique combination of nature's peace and quiet and a bubbly city within walking distance.

The site measures 13.6 acres, whereby 80 to 100 square metres are allocated to each camping pitch. Delftse Hout offers 50 camper-van sites, 120 tourist sites and 50 'comfort sites' with their own cable television, water, mains and electricity connections. Free wireless internet is also available. Delftse Hout is situated on the edge of the city and the cosy Market square is only a fifteen-minute walk away. As you can see, the camping site offers you a varied holiday with many options. Delft also offers a wide range of activities, sights and experiences!

A spotless camping site

Delftse Hout Recreation Centre offers everything for a great holiday. You can start the day with freshly-baked buns from the on-site supermarket. There is a convenient launderette to deal with your dirty laundry. And if you prefer others to cook for you during your holidays, you can always enjoy a meal in our restaurant or snack bar.

The first thing that you will notice is that Delftse Hout is a well-maintained recreation centre. We feel strongly about maintenance and hygiene on our premises. The entire site looks clean and tidy and our hygienic sanitary facilities can be used without any worries. An enthusiastic team is keen to keep the entire place spotless. The showers can be used free of charge. If you are visiting our camping site with little children, it will be good to know that - in designing facilities - we have also kept them in mind. Delftse Hout has special children's sanitary facilities for little children up to the age of six and also have family showers where you and your children can take a shower together!

Of course, you can bring your own bicycles when you come and visit us, but this is not really necessary because you can also hire them from us. A bicycle tour is a real must: the country side that surrounds Delft is a lovely area to explore. You can go to the greenhouses in the Westland area, roam parts of the 'Groene Hart' (Green Heart), a national landscape of the Netherlands, or visit the coast: possibilities galore. Another nice thing is that the recreation grounds are a low-traffic zone, allowing limited access to cars. No more than one car is allowed per hired pitch. Visitors can make use of the large car park at the entrance to the recreation grounds.

Delftse Hout Recreation Centre is situated amidst beautiful nature. At about two kilometres east of the A13 motorway (running from Rotterdam to The Hague), Delftse Hout can easily be reached.

By car

If travelling by car, take exit 9 (Delft) on the A13 and head for 'Delft - centrum'. Immediately after the second set of traffic lights, turn right into 'Staalweg'. Blue/white camping signs indicating the route have already been placed along the A13 motorway.

Public transport

When making use of public transport, you can take bus number 80/82 at Delft railway station. Every twenty minutes there will be a bus from the station to the camping site and back. The bus ride takes about 10 minutes and the bus stop is situated 500 metres from the camping entrance.

With its variety of accommodation options it will be no surprise that Delftse Hout is open all year round. In any season it is really worthwhile visiting this area with its wide range of attractions. Delftse Hout is an excellent basis for exploring the surrounding area!

Sunhome (2 people): on-site caravan equipped with one bedroom, a living room, cooking facilities, a bathroom with a shower, toilet and washbasin, a colour television, and heating. A terrace area with garden furniture.

Camping Cottage (4 people): equipped with two bedrooms, a living room, a kitchen with a refrigerator, a bathroom with a shower, toilet and washbasin, and a colour television. Sporty accommodation, particularly suitable for families with children. Garden furniture.

Grass-roofed eco-bungalow (5 people): equipped with two bedrooms, a bathroom with a shower, toilet and washbasin, a washing machine with a dryer, a colour television, and a modern kitchen. Peacefully situated. A terrace area with garden furniture.
